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## Course Descriptions

<p><b>PE Club</b> Mr. Dowling Grades 4-6 \$99</p> <p>Mondays, 8:15-9:15am Gym 4/8, 4/22, 4/29, 5/6, 5/13, 5/20, 6/3</p>	<p>Students will participate in various intramural sports (such as basketball, floor hockey, soccer, badminton, and other modified skill-themed games) and fitness-related activities with an emphasis on skill development, game strategies, teamwork, and sportsmanship as well as health and fitness.</p>
<p><b>Mandarin</b> Little Linguists Arts Academy Grades K-6 \$174</p> <p>Mondays, 4:10-5:10pm Big Music Room 4/8, 4/22, 4/29, 5/6, 5/13, 5/20, 6/3</p>	<p>Learning comes naturally with our proprietary curriculum that integrates culture with language to give children a sense of context that deepens the educational experience. <p><b>Coding with Scratch</b> Silver Knights Enrichment Grades 2-6 \$199</p> <p>Tuesdays, 8:15-9:15am POD 4/2, 4/9, 4/23, 4/30, 5/7, 5/14, 5/21, 5/28</p>	<p>In Coding Club, you will learn to code your own interactive animations, stories and games using Scratch. Scratch is a fun and creative way to learn programming skills and computational thinking. Our curriculum was designed for kids who are new to coding or have experience and are ready for more advanced concepts. When you're coding with Scratch, the only limit is your imagination! Each session has fun new projects!</p>

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<p><b>Basketball &amp; Flag Football</b>          Kids in Motion          Grades K-6          \$139</p> <p>Tuesdays, 4:10-5:10pm          Gym/Outdoors          4/2, 4/9, 4/23, 4/30, 5/7, 5/14, 5/21, 5/28</p>	<p>In Basketball &amp; Flag Football, we teach students the fundamentals of running, dribbling, catching, passing, and shooting. Younger students use games to learn basic skills such as Red Light, Green Light, Stop and Go Dribble, Passing Line Relay, Shuffle Pass Relay, and Circle Block Out. Older students work on learning the fundamentals and then scrimmaging once the basic skills are mastered. This is a team sport, with warm ups, cool downs, drills, and games done individually, in pairs, and as a group. The value of teamwork and sportsmanship is essential and emphasized in the game of basketball. In class athletes learn to pass, catch, run, and punt through drills, games, and scrimmages. The goal is to have fun while being physically active, and coaches stress the importance of working hard with the best attitude possible for a great after school activity!</p>
<p><b>Python Coding</b>          Coder Kids          Grades 4-6          \$203</p> <p>Tuesdays, 4:10-5:10pm          POD          4/2, 4/9, 4/23, 4/30, 5/7, 5/14, 5/21, 5/28</p>	<p>Coder Kids set off on a coding adventure by learning to code in this popular programming language used by Youtube, Netflix, and Google. After completing this course, Coder Kids will be able to use the PyCharm Python editor to create their own Python files, run code, experiment with the Python Console, and resolve bugs. They will also be able to create their own computer graphics using the Turtle library. Finally, they will use conditionals and other programming logic to design an A.I. to play Tic-Tac-Toe.</p>
